ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE INFORMATION

Since there will be members of your group flying in from many different locations, it is unfortunately not possible for our Instructors to meet participants at departure or connecting airports. Your Instructors will meet you at George Town, Exuma International Airport (GGT). Plan to arrive at the **George Town Airport (GGT)** between **Noon and 4:00 p.m.** on **July 20th**. For those that have other participants from their area joining us on the trip, we will put you in touch so that, if you wish, you can coordinate your flights. Please get in touch if you have any questions about booking your flight. If you need to contact us on your travel day, please call 781.585.3459 or 800.585.2523.

Please note that it is possible to fly through Nassau, Bahamas, and connect with Bahamas Air or other carriers to George Town (GGT). If you would like to do this, please understand that our Instructors will be at the airport in George Town and unfortunately not be able to facilitate their connection.

If flying, please check with your airline to make sure that you are aware of any excess baggage or unaccompanied minor fees. If necessary, please make arrangements to pay for this on the return flight. If you are flying as an unaccompanied minor, we can provide you with the name and contact information for your Instructor, who can meet you at your gate.

When arriving by air, bring critical items in your carry-on, in the event your luggage is delayed. Wear your Williwaw T-Shirt so that we can easily identify each other.

For departure, make plans to leave between **8:00 am** and **Noon** on **August 6**.

Please e-mail us your travel information when you have finalized your plans.

HEALTH INSURANCE AND TRIP INSURANCE

Many health insurance policies will cover you in The Bahamas, but we encourage you to confirm this with your health insurance provider to make sure you are adequately covered for health care as well as emergency transportation needs.
